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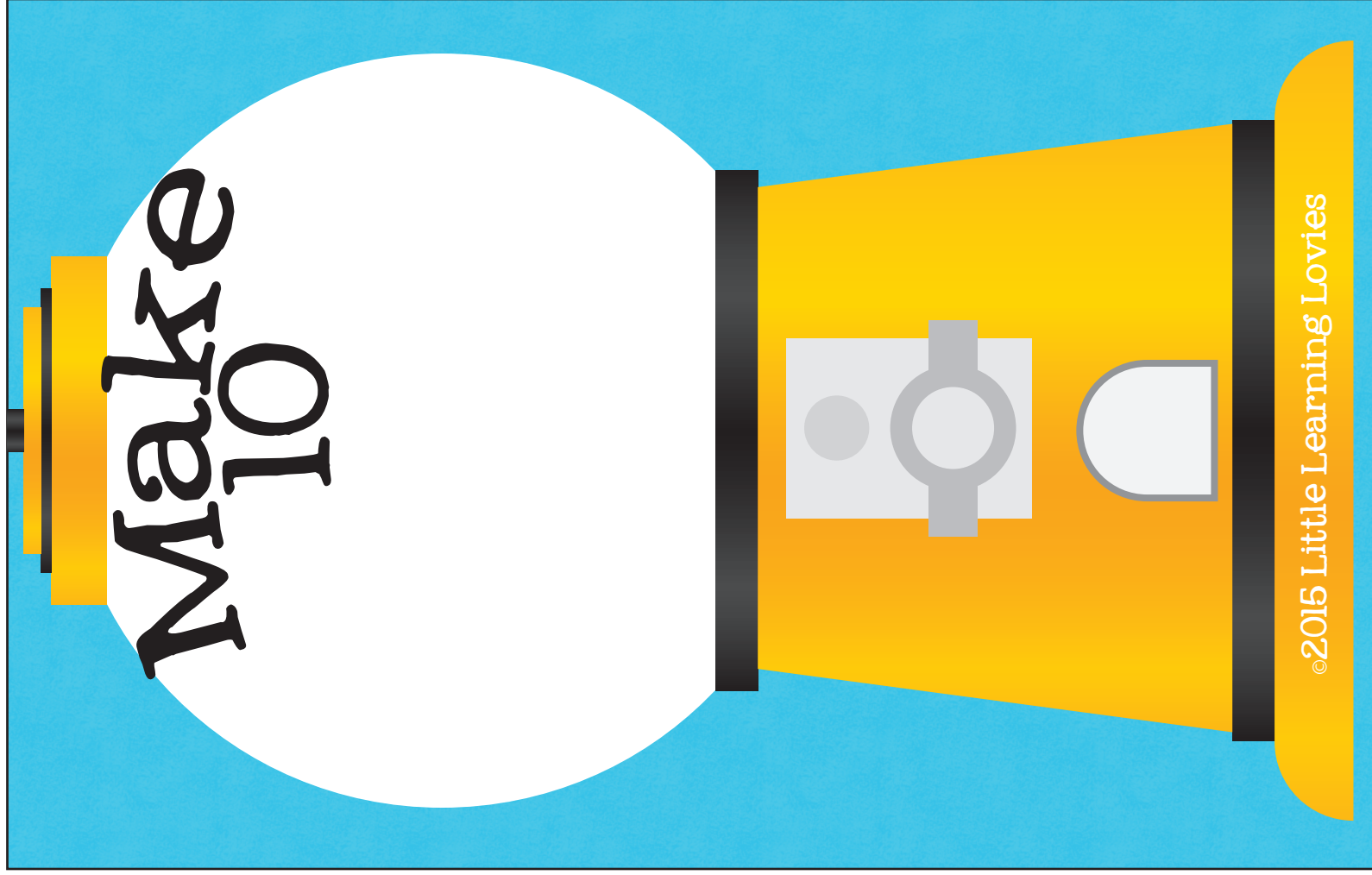
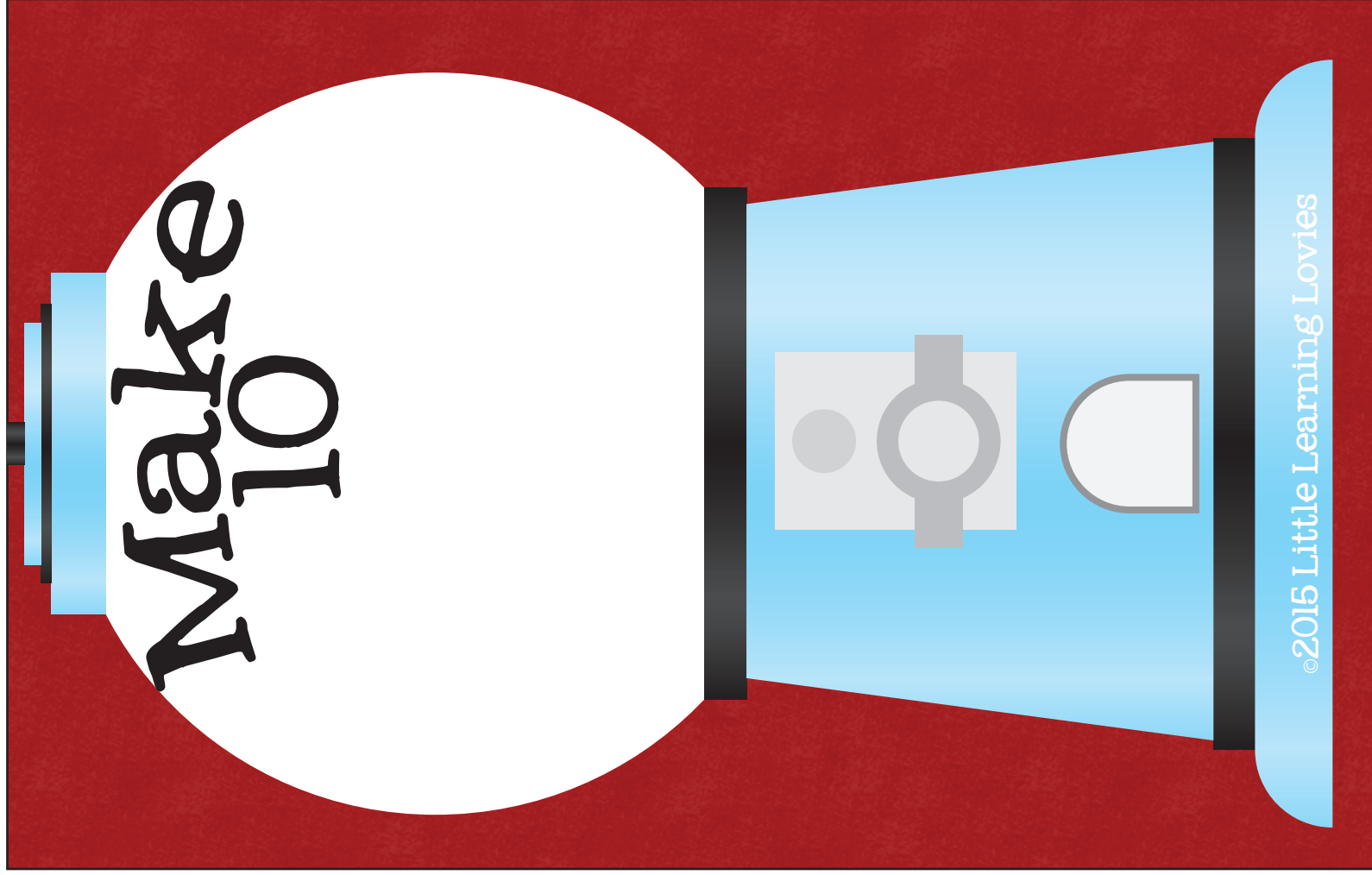

Instructions

Each player gets a mat.

Number tiles are placed in a brown paper bag.

The goal is to make exactly ten with your tiles.

Players take turns picking one number tile from the bag and placing it on their mat. Players only pick one tile per turn.

When one player goes OVER 10, everyone else scores the # of points on their mat and the player that went over scores 0.

When one player makes exactly 10, that player scores a 10 and everyone else scores 0.

Game is over when one player reaches or passes 50 points.

There is LOTS of adding practice in this game. It's perfect for 1st graders.

Younger players can play, too, but it's best to have an older player in charge of keeping score. Make sure the young ones tell their score each round to the score keeper!
