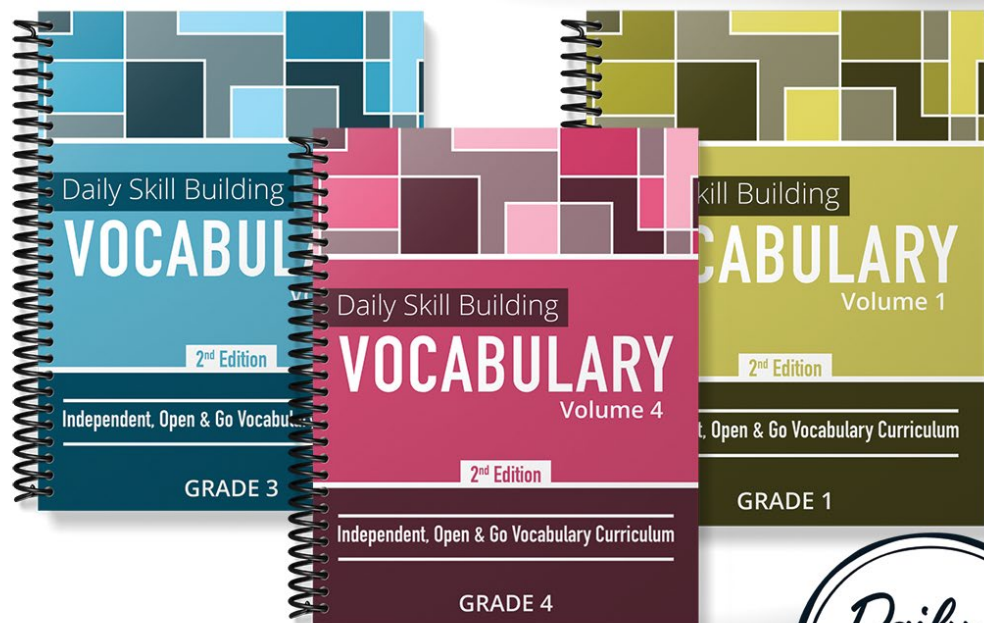

Transition Words to Add Emphasis: absolutely, again, always, definitely, especially, in fact, never, particularly, to emphasize, truly

Beginning Transition Words: first, first of all, in the beginning, one time, once upon a time

Changing Transition Words: at the same time, in contrast, instead, however, nevertheless, otherwise, yet

Transition Words for Clarification: after all, as expected, clearly, for instance, for this reason, in other words, generally speaking, namely, obviously, of course, surely, usually

Comparison Transition Words: also, as well as, comparatively, equally, in contrast, however, in the same way, instead, for the same reason, likewise, on one hand, on the other hand, similarly, too

Transition Words for Conclusion: accordingly, all in all, as a result, as you can see, hence, in conclusion, finally, for all those reasons, in summary, in other words, lastly, overall, to sum it up, to summarize, therefore, thus

Transition Words Indicating to Continue or More Information: in addition, additionally, also, besides, in fact, furthermore, moreover, lastly, next
