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

Numerals are alphabetized exactly how they are written, not as they would be spelled. Example: 101 Dalmations 800 numbers 5. Abbreviations are alphabetized exactly as written, not as they would be spelled. Example: doctor Dr. Jordan 6. General alphabetization rules First symbols (\$,%,#), then numerals, then letters. Example: \$7 per hour 20 Books to Read Charlotte's Web
