PREPOSITIONS CHEAT SHEET

Prepositions can indicate location EXAMPLE: The cat climed up the tree. up the tree is the prepositional phrase

Prepositions can show location in time EXAMPLE: Brush your teeth after you eat. after you eat is the *prepositional phrase*

Prepositional phrase: Begins with the preposition and ends with the noun/pronoun (see examples above)

Object of the preposition: Noun/pronoun that ends prepositional phrase
