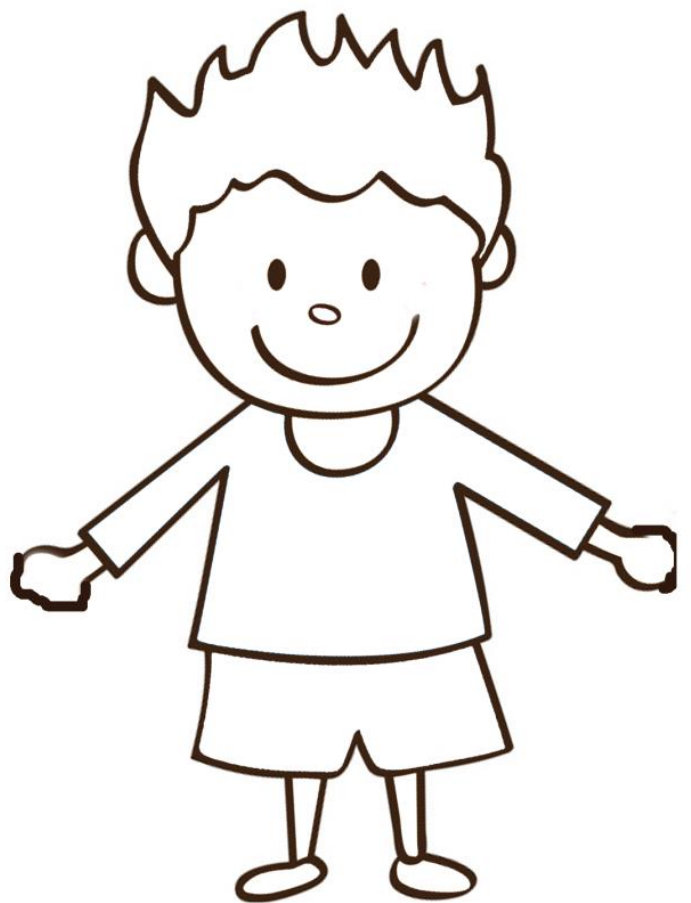

Discussion

Read [Just the Way I Am](#) and talk about the ways that we are all different. We have different faces, different colors, different accents, different talents and capabilities. Help your child to understand how these differences don’t make one person any more or less special than another. We are all created by God and uniquely made for His purpose!

Craft

Collect newspaper clippings, books, magazine ads, or even go online. Look at pictures of people and point out all the different facial features and color of hair and skin. Look at pictures of nature and point out the different structures and colors. Talk about how God created all of the earth and the people on it and what an amazing artist He is to be able to not only create all that we see but the souls within those people as well.

It is very important to use this moment to share the Gospel with your children. How no matter what color you are, talents you have, stuff you own we are all sinners (Romans 3:23) and need God to save us. It is only through Christ that we can be saved (John 14:6). God requires faith (Ephesians 2:8-9) and obedience (John 14:15) which He gives through the Holy Spirit.
