

Yom Kippur Verses

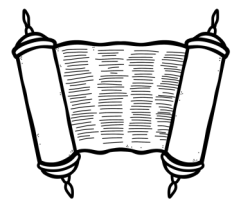

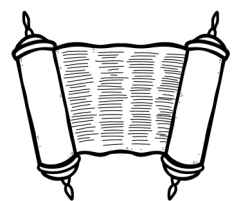

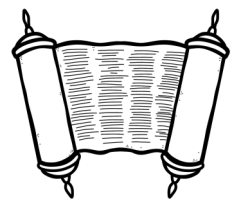
