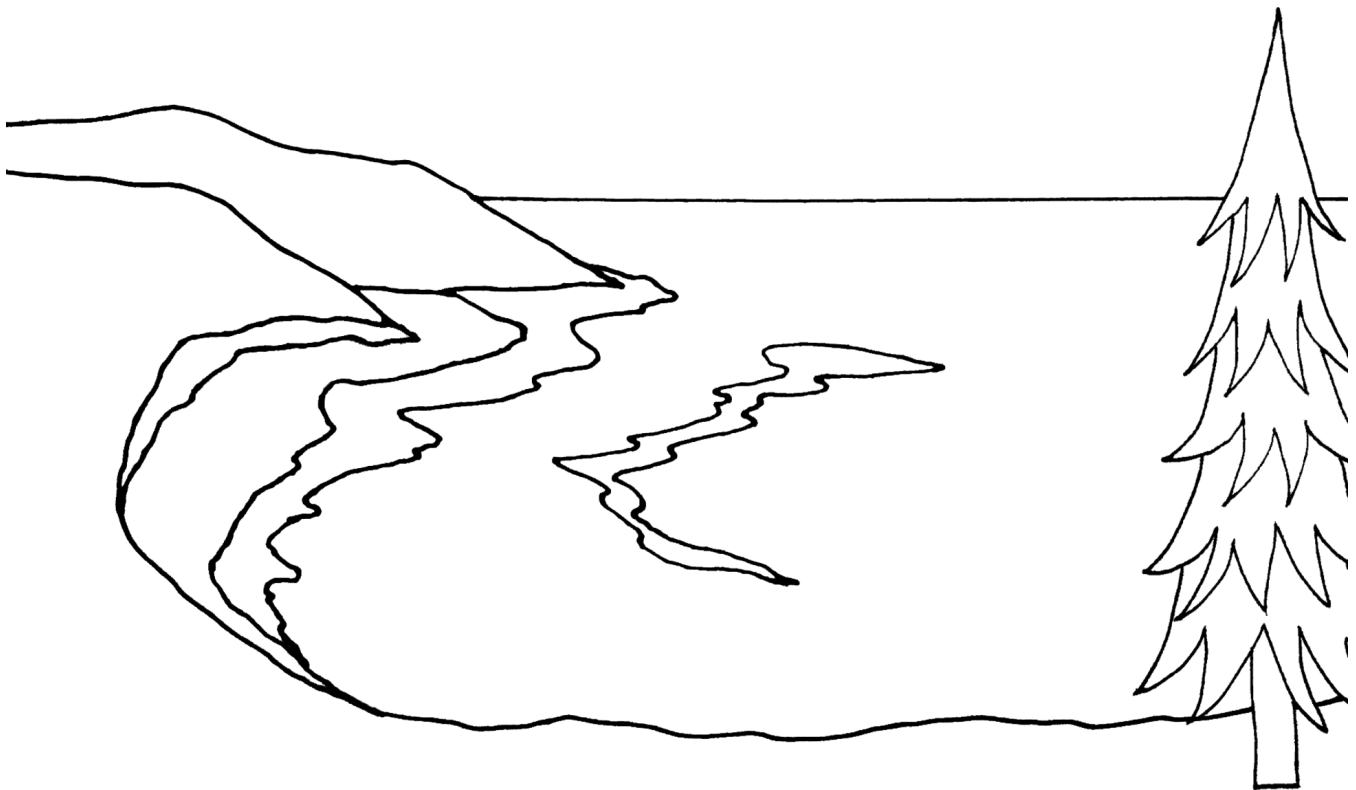


Print & Cursive Connections: American Explorers & Frontiersmen
