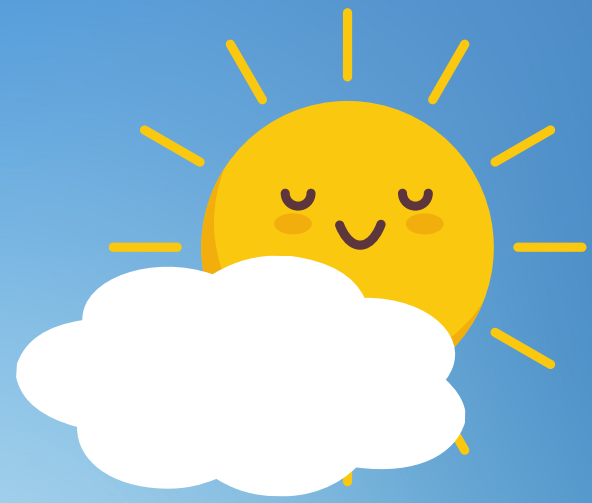

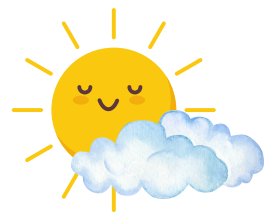

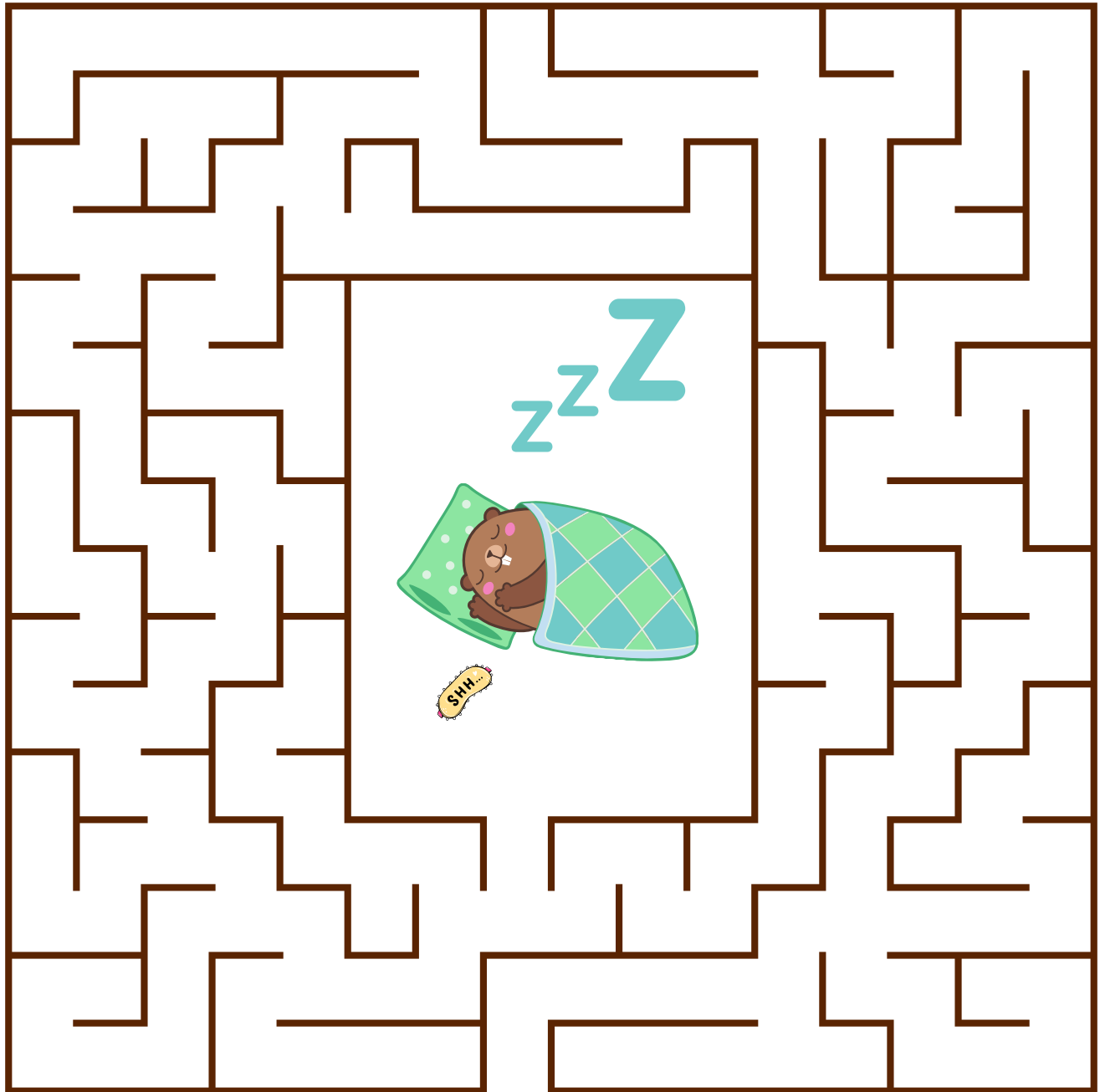
Trace the Paths

Do you think the groundhog will see his shadow on February 2nd? Circle your answer.

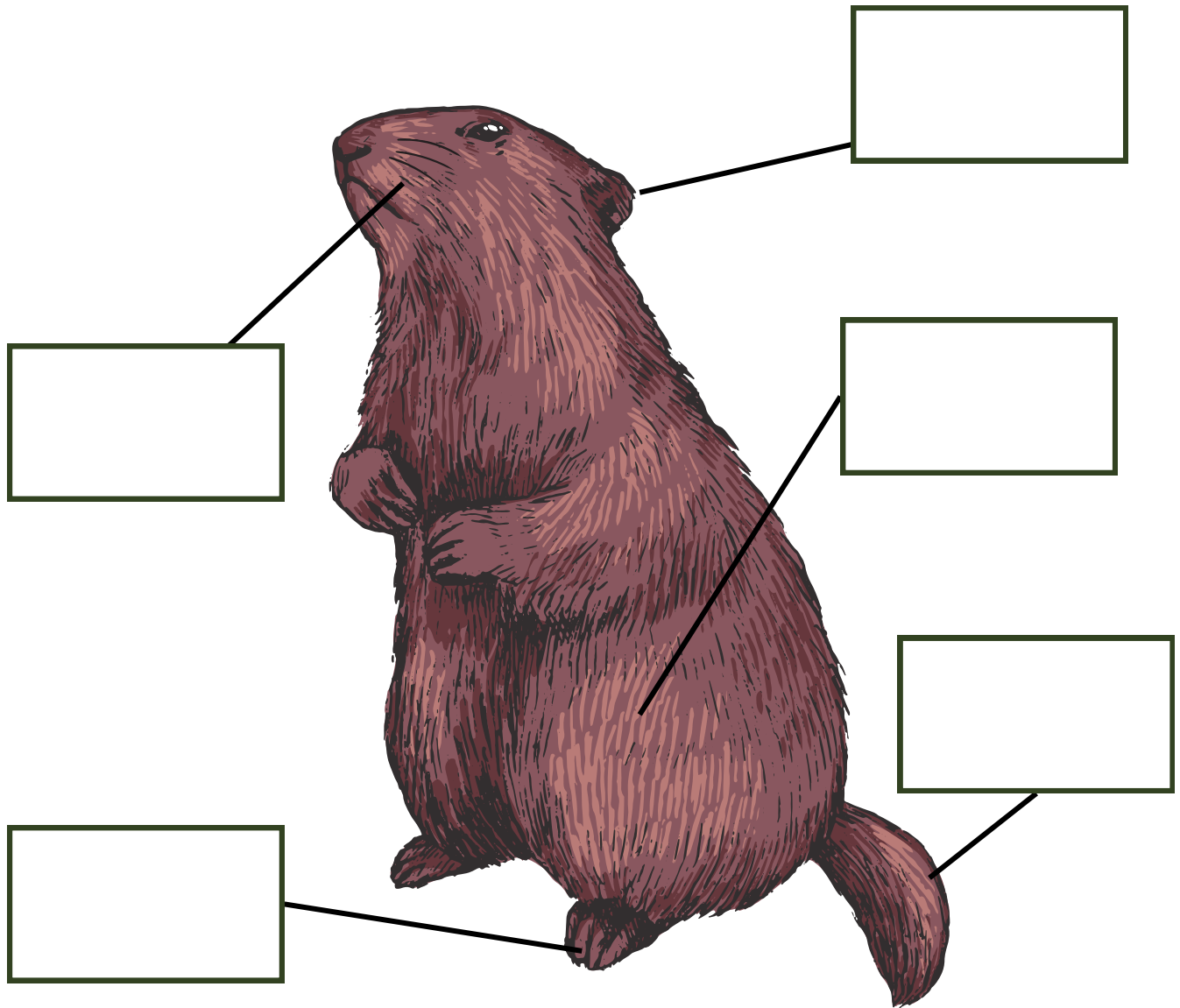
Yes = Add a sun and his shadow.
