#### 1. Create Your Fair Games

- Choose a few fun "booths" to set up.
- o Choose what's in each booth (snacks, small toys, or pretend items).
  - Food stands
  - Game booths
  - Souvenir or toy shop

#### 2. Decide Tickets & Items

 Decide how many tickets each booth will charge. Make sure each works with a 9× fact!

# 3. Make Tickets

- Create or cut out tickets.
- Make enough tickets for each player to use for their purchases.

### 4. Buy Tickets at the Ticket Booth

- Each player starts with some money or points (real or pretend).
- Go to the ticket booth and "buy" tickets in multiples of 9.
- Example: 9 tickets cost \$1, 18 tickets cost \$2, 27 tickets cost \$3, etc

# 5. Play & Practice the 9 Multiplication Tricks in the Story

- Buy items or play games using the 9 facts
- Try using all the 9 tricks in the story
- Which one do you like using the best?

### 6. Write it Down

- Write down the multiplication facts you use in a notebook just like just like Hattie did in the story.
- ★ Bonus Challenge: Can you create your own new trick for remembering a 9 fact?
